FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How do I know what the next event is?

A: Events that are ready for booking are updated online on the 15th of month prior to the event.

For those who cannot use the online system you need to phone Kayleen on the 15th of the month to find out what the event is and book remembering we have a 'first booked first seated' policy.

Q: Can I travel only occassionally?

A: Yes, you can book only the events that interest you.

Q: What day are events?

A: Usually the 2nd Wednesday of each month.

Q: How long are events?

A: Usually leave 10:30am and return 2:30pm approx.
